



Elected Office Campaign Assignment

This assignment will consist of 3 main parts. I will go into each of the parts below. You will need to manage your time as each part is a required part of this assignment. Below you will find a description of each of the required components.

Poster - Your poster must be on a poster board larger than 8 1/2 by 11 (white or binder paper). Your poster needs to include a picture of you and the office you are running for. Your poster should be colorful and inviting.

Speech - Your speech should talk about who you are and why we should vote for you. Talk about your positive qualities and what you will bring to the position. You can not talk negatively about the people you are running against. Your speech should be about a minute long which is about 1 page written on binder paper. Your speech should be typed and memorized as much as possible. You will be graded on content and your voice or volume when presenting your speech.

Campaign Button or Token - This is a little treat, sticker, button, etc. that you will give each student telling them to vote for you. Creativity is always appreciated.

Speech Due September 30th

Speeches October 1st and 2nd

Campaign Button or Token Due on day of Speech

Voting October 6th

You will have some time to work on your speech in class but you will not have time to work on your poster or Button/Token in class. Make sure you use your time as wisely as possible. Do not save this for the last minute.
